Pastor KrisAnne's Korner

My journey with prayer is interesting. I was a very extroverted, active and imaginative kid, happy to say prayers with my family at mealtime and before bed. Mostly compliant to sit through the LONG prayers at church, though not without getting fidgety in my seat, and I would let Dad know if he prayed too long from the pulpit. None of these prayers were overly meaningful to me; it all seemed very boring and ineffective. What was the point? Some of that, I'm sure, was because I was just a child and needed to grow up a little. But even into my teen years, connecting with God in prayer was hard. To the point that I struggled to do it at all. I knew I should praise God for who He is, thank God for what He has done, ask God for what I need and what my loved ones need, and then thank Him for hearing my requests. Inside, all I could think was, blah, blah, blah...

That is, until I met a woman at church who taught me to pray in new ways. First, she admitted that everyone feels like prayer is boring at times. I was relieved to hear that I was normal and not irredeemable! But she also encouraged me to just keep at it and trust that joy and peace would return after a time. Secondly, she taught me to journal my conversations with God (about anything!) and then take time once in a while to look back and see how God worked things out to move me along in my spiritual walk. It's hard for me to describe the joy and gratitude I discovered when I actually did that. I have such a short memory and I can easily miss out on what God's doing when I don't reflect back on things.

Third, this woman taught me to pray with scripture in a way that made Jesus come alive for me all over again. She encouraged me to put myself into the biblical stories and then talk to Jesus about what I noticed, what I felt, what questions I had... and then



to simply listen for His word to me in the quiet. Now, I can often speak to Jesus as a brother and friend. Not always, but our conversations are easier, more comfortable and intimate, because I've grown to trust Him. As I've looked back, as I've kept practicing, and as I've let scripture soak into my soul, I've met Him there and prayer can actually be exciting!

I hope in this sermon series, you will discover new ways to pray and that it will become exciting for you as well!
