
Pastor KrisAnne's Korner

We've talked about simplicity in prayer - no need for fancy words or even a concern for theological correctness. We are invited to pray as children, to a loving and attentive Father who already knows what we need. We've looked at the idea of "praying continually" or "unceasing communion" with Jesus, making prayer the thing that holds all the other things in our lives together instead of treating it like another item on our to-do list.

Then we looked at confession in prayer, the importance of taking an honest inventory of ourselves in humility and then trusting the grace of God to embrace us, cleanse us, and make us new again. Last week we talked about partnering with God in prayer through action and intercession. Robin did a fantastic job of sharing how she partners with God through prayer in her work with World Vision.

Let me give you a quick peak into where we're going next. We'll take a look at the Psalms as an entire book of prayers, with lots of diversity throughout. Then we'll examine some of the prayers of the early church in Acts and Ephesians. As a fun way to wrap up the summer, we will look at the prayers of a few Old Testament characters: Esther, Jonah and Daniel. I'm pretty excited about those Sundays!

In the meantime, this Sunday is going to be a special day! We have the privilege to be led into worship and Word by sisters and brothers from Zimbabwe. The older I get, the more I realize how narrow my view of faith is, even my view of God. The Christian church is so big and it seems



to me, we each experience God uniquely from our vantage point... which is valuable, but also incomplete. Whenever we expand our horizons by worshipping alongside people from another culture, we can see more of God and our faith gets deeper and wider. I am so looking forward to this Sunday, and I hope you are, too. Thank you to our Zimbabwean brothers and sisters for leading us!




