Pastor KrisAnne's Korner

Words are so interesting. They can mean one thing in one moment and a completely different thing in another, depending on the context or the speaker's tone or the word's place in the sentence. Consider the word "fall." It can be a noun, meaning autumn; or a verb, meaning drop. Similarly, a wave can be something you see in the ocean or a gesture you give to a passerby on the street.

In the text I'm preaching on this Sunday, we find the word **bold**. I spent some time exploring that word, and it became more interesting as I went along. **Bold** can be something we do with our writing or typing, printing things in **boldface**. When we do that, we draw attention to those words signaling that they are important. But there are more ways to use the word. **Bold** as a characteristic of a person or group of people can carry either a positive or negative meaning. There are **bold** people who are presumptuous and disrespectful, and there are **bold** people who are brave in the face of danger.

All of this is pretty interesting when I think about the first Christians. In Acts 4, Peter and John came back from an encounter with the chief priests and Jewish elders, and they told the other believers what was said by these authorities. The group's response was to pray, and they pray for... you guessed it...boldness. In the face of opposition, that is what they chose to ask God for. I wonder why.



They could have prayed for many other things protection, punishment for their enemies, rescue from danger. But their desire was to be **bold** as they continued to act as witnesses for Jesus.

Take a few moments between now and Sunday to consider what that says to you, how that strikes you or moves you. Talk to God about it... and/or reach out to me; I'd love to have a conversation with you! See you Sunday!
