#### Pastor KrisAnne's Korner

I had a grandmother who used to say, "Be careful what you pray for!" I think she knew from experience that sometimes God answers our prayers in unexpected and maybe even disruptive ways. We pray for stronger faith and God asks us to step out and take a risk. We pray for more love for the people in our lives, and we find that love often means sacrifice.

In our scripture text this Sunday, two men approach God in prayer. We actually aren't told that they were specifically asking God for anything. Perhaps they were simply listening in silence in His Presence. As they are praying an angel speaks to one of them, and the other receives a strange vision and hears the voice of God. As a result, their lives are completely disrupted! Peter learns that the Gospel isn't just for his people, the Jews, but for everyone, even Roman soldiers (let's not forget that Roman soldiers were the ones who executed Jesus). Cornelius learns that there is much more to honoring God than praying regularly and giving to the poor. There is a living Savior, Jesus, to follow; and the Holy Spirit which will fill and empower him and all who believe.

Something I'm pondering this week is how often - if ever - we expect to be disrupted in prayer. I pray to feel comfort, to be encouraged, to receive reassurance if I've failed. I pray for guidance, yes, and for God to reveal truth to me; but I confess I hardly ever expect for my life to be turned upside down as a result. I'm someone who likes structure and order. I don't actually appreciate disruption. But as I've been reflecting on Cornelius and Peter, and the beautiful ending to this story; I wonder what I've been missing by not being more open to the Holy Spirit's disruption in my life. What if I've been missing out on witnessing the power of the



Gospel to transform lives, because I'm stuck in my routine... because I haven't been open and free and listening for a new direction, a new word from God, a fresh wind of the Spirit taking me into new territory?

If you can identify with me here, let's try something new. Let's be less careful what we pray for this week. Let's tell God that we're open to anything as long as it's His Will, and then see how He disrupts our lives in the best way possible!


