Pastor KrisAnne's Korner

True confession - I don't like mirrors. And I like very few pictures of myself, to be honest. I have this sense in my head of what I look like and then I'm shocked (often not in a good way!) when I see an actual image. Is that really what I look like, I want to ask? Ugh! On the other hand, mirrors can be helpful if I have crusties in the corner of my eye or something in my teeth or a bit of lunch smeared on my cheek. I can't fix what I can't see, and I would prefer not to be walking around with any of those things on my face.

Switching topics for a moment, our friend Jonah is what we might call an anti-hero. Usually the Old Testament prophets are held in high esteem and lauded as faithful messengers of God who brought the Word of God to the people. Jonah, on the other hand, tries to avoid his calling, even to the point of asking to be thrown overboard into the sea. He's grumpy, disobedient, selfcentered and judgmental. Yet he's the main character of this book in our scriptures, and he's the instrument through which God saves an entire people, the Ninevites.

Interesting, right? It makes you wonder what the point of the book is. Why does it put this unsavory character who behaves badly, even to the very end, right at the center? Have you guessed where I'm going with this yet? Jonah acts as a mirror for God's people. This isn't my original idea; thanks to Tim Mackie and Jon Collins of The Bible Project for the analogy! And if it's true that the book is a mirror, the image we see isn't pretty or pleasant. There's something



to be fixed. God is helping us see where His image in us has been smudged or twisted or damaged. And He wants to make us beautiful again.

The story leaves us hanging at the end. It closes with a question and just stops. Between now and Sunday, take some time to read Jonah and ponder the question at the end. Ask God what He might be showing you through this mirror. Even if you don't like the image you see, God is always for you and His mercy is never failing. You can trust that.
