Pastor KrisAnne's Korner

This Sunday we are going to talk about confession. When it comes to this topic, the apostle John pulls no punches: "If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." (1 John 1:8-9)

He's not writing to unbelievers here, but to those who have already chosen to follow Jesus. Meaning, the assumption is that Christians still have things to confess. John expects that we will continue to sin. I'm taking the time to point that out because it's not often that we practice individual or corporate confession on Sunday mornings when we gather for worship. One might think we are a gathering of the pure. A gathering of the righteous, the good ones. We used to be sinners, but thank goodness, we are no longer!

And in one sense, yes, that is true. Through Jesus, God has declared us righteous, blameless saints. But each of us could name a list of sins we struggle with, because we <u>have been</u> saved, but we are <u>still</u> being saved, too. Our lists might include things like lying, gluttony, gossip, vanity, sloth, selfishness, lust, divisiveness, slander, bitterness and anger. We are living in the in-between, where our new self in Christ is alive within us, but our old self still battles for our time and attention.

Thank goodness God's compassion is "new every morning" (Lamentations 3:22-23)! The apostle John assures us that as we confess our sins, God will faithfully forgive them. Again? Yes, again. And again? Yes, over and over again. And not only that, John says that God will continue to purify us as we name our sins. The practice of confession and forgiveness opens us up to God's power to purify and transform.



It may feel foreign to you - I admit that it does to me! -but be intentional about reviewing your days this week and confessing your sins. Receive God's forgiveness for the bad things that you have done and the good things that you have left undone. Open up to the Spirit's purifying power. See what happens. This simple practice might bring more change into your life than you anticipate!
