Pastor KrisAnne's Korner

Ben Cassel is preaching this Sunday, continuing our series in Ephesians. Two of the verses from the section he's preaching on say this: "There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called; one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all who is over all and through all and in all."

These words reminded me of an old hymn-<u>The</u> <u>Church's One Foundation</u>. I offer you the lyrics to reflect on this week, as we prepare for Sunday:

By schisms rent as under, by heresies distressed, Yet saints their watch are keeping, their cry goes up, "How long?"


And soon the night of weeping shall be the morn of song.
