Pastor KrisAnne's Korner

Thanksgiving feels especially festive at our house this year. Our distant college kids are back home, filling our house with their chatter and humor... and laundry. The thanksgiving menu is one of our favorite meals, so we're all anticipating the big feast on Thursday. We have plans with friends and extended family whom we haven't seen for quite a while. There are special outdoor decorating plans in the works (it sounds like we're going to join in the cone Christmas tree fad that has taken over Hilltown Township in the last few years!). I am soaking up the energy and excitement after a quiet autumn of empty nesting!

I spoke last Sunday about generosity and thanksgiving. How it is God's own generosity that we are called to mirror and share with one another and the world. How generosity is part of sharing the Good News of Jesus with others, and results in thanksgiving to God. I confess that right now, it's easy for my heart to overflow with generosity and thanksgiving - I'm really feeling it! But that is not always the case. Some days it's hard to be generous and give thanks; sometimes adult responsibilities and stress steal my joy. In those moments generosity and thanksgiving are things I intentionally practice; they aren't a natural overflow of my heart. That's part of the human journey, and it's not a surprise to our patient and gracious Lord. Whatever your heart is feeling this Thanksgiving holiday - an overflow of gratitude and generosity or stuck in the slog of the daily grind - offer it to Jesus. Trust Him to meet you there and walk you through it. His Loving Presence is our anchor in everything.

Here is a prayer from the book <u>The Narrow Path</u>, which we'll be using January - March in our small groups. It may be helpful for you this week as you consider generosity and thanksgiving:



Father, you are an abundant giver.

There is nothing we have that you have not given us.

The way of your kingdom is the way of generosity.

Help us to honor you with our resources.

Free us from the deceit of riches.

Lead us on the path of generosity.

For your glory, Lord.

And for the abundance of our own lives, and the sake of others.
