Pastor KrisAnne's Korner

It's hard to believe there are only a few weeks left in 2024. As we look ahead to 2025, I want to talk about the new small group initiative we're starting, which will be part of our church-wide journey through the Sermon on the Mount:

Why small groups? I do recognize that a commitment to a small group will be one more thing to add to our already busy schedules. However, there is nothing quite as impactful for discipleship and church growth, as small groups meeting regularly to share, study and pray together. This is how Jesus structured his whole ministry. Crowds followed Him, but he shared daily life with twelve. He shared even more with just three others. When he sent the disciples out to do ministry, they were sent out in pairs, to share the experience together. In my own life, I notice that the years I spent intentionally connecting with a few other believers - for ministry or simply in friendship - those years have been the most transformative of my life.

Church growth. Like many congregations in our community over the past decade or so, SBIC has experienced lower attendance numbers. Many of you remember the days when the pews were filled for worship and ministry programs were buzzing with activity. Many of you long for those days, but we all know it's impossible to return to the past. However, I've said this before and I'll say it again - This congregation has something very special to offer the community: the genuineness of our relationships, the way we pray for one another and bear each other's burdens, our partnership across languages and cultures, our focus on Jesus, and our love of scripture and desire to apply it to our lives. But how do we get the word out, that this is who we are and what we have to offer?

Not many people will walk into a church they have no connection to, on a Sunday morning. But if they have been invited to someone's home for conversation and prayer, and if the love and authenticity they experience there impacts them in a positive way - maybe even makes them long for God - there is little doubt in my mind that they will show up for Sunday worship.



Evangelism doesn't have to be strangers on street corners handing out pamphlets. It can be as simple as saying to your co-worker or neighbor (or mechanic or barista or....), "Hey, a couple of us are meeting once a month to read this book together and talk about it (or watch this video series or whatever). It's pretty interesting and I think you'd like it. Want to join us next time?" And then prayerfully trust God to do what God does: reach people with His Love and Good News.

I have a dream... a healthy network of small groups, where people are known and loved and feel that they belong. A dream that these groups will be vehicles of love and belonging that reach out, transforming our neighborhoods and our church.
