Pastor KrisAnne's Korner

This Sunday we will have the privilege of hearing from John Hawbaker, a missions advocate for BIC World Missions. He's the first of two speakers that we will hear from prior to our Zimbabwe team flying to Africa.

Many of you may not even know how this Zimbabwe Missions and Learning Trip came to be - and here we are with 17 people preparing to go in July! Well, let me tell you the story:

Not long after I started here at SBIC as your pastor, I sat down with Miselani Ndlovu, who was serving on church board at the time. I asked her how I could best support and minister to our Zimbabwean families. One of the things I love about our congregation is that we are made up of people from various cultures and ethnicities. To me, this beautifully reflects the diversity in the global Kingdom of God... And we have so much to learn from each other about who God is because of our differing backgrounds, experiences and perspectives on Christian faith and discipleship.

In our conversation, Miselani shared with me that if I really wanted to know, understand and be able to minister well to my Zimbabwean brothers and sisters, I should visit Zimbabwe. My heart immediately wanted to say yes! I love to travel and visit different places, and I knew that she was right - nothing can compare to visiting someone's home! But of course, I wasn't sure when I would go or how all the details would work out. I spoke to Rob Light, our church board chair, and he encouraged me to think a bit bigger about the interesting invitation to go halfway around the world. This led to much prayer and several conversations with the full board, and finally a decision to plan on the summer of 2025 and to open the opportunity up to the larger congregation.

The Ndlovu's and Moyo's have been wonderful connections to the BIC mission stations and congregations in the city of Bulawayo and surrounding areas. Our team of 17 is looking forward to worshipping with several churches and visiting three mission stations while we are in country. There is much for us to learn about Zimbabwe and the tribes that make up this beautiful country. There are also plenty of projects we .



will be helping with at the missions - painting, building, perhaps putting up a new water tank.

I am most looking forward to how God will expand our hearts and minds while we are there. It's normal and very human to think that the way we worship and "do church" is the normal way. We might even say "the right way." But to visit our brothers and sisters in the faith in their context, to see how God has led them to worship and minister and grow as disciples -- I am confident we will learn that our way, here in suburban America, is only one of many ways to express faith and to do discipleship. Faithfulness to Jesus looks different in different contexts, and I hope our team comes back with a new awareness of that reality and a bigger imagination for how we can be faithful to Jesus here in Bux-Mont Pennsylvania.

Whether or not you are participating in this trip by actually boarding the airplane and flying across the ocean, this trip belongs to all of us at Souderton BIC. Thank you for your support, your prayers and the many ways you all are stepping up to make this mission and learning trip happen. May God renew and refresh us all through this experience. Amen.


My Coins Count


