Pastor KrisAnne's Korner

"No use crying over spilled milk. You don't make something better by whining about it. Don't wallow in sadness; get on with life." I probably heard a form of all of these sayings at some point in my life. I come from a long line of stoic farmers and hard workers who endured hardship and overcame it in order to provide something better for their children and grandchildren. These folks didn't necessarily value emotional expressions of any kind, positive or negative. They valued a good work ethic, sacrificing for your family, and the strength to bear whatever life handed you.

I inherited the work ethic, but for sure I didn't inherit the stoicism of my ancestors. I tend to be a ball of emotions (some of you may have noticed this by now, haha!). I remember telling my mom once when she was chiding me about my strong feelings over something that had happened at school, "But I feel EVERYTHING, Mom! EVERYTHING!" With age and experience, I've probably tempered a little bit. I'm not quite the volatile teenager I once was, thank goodness, but I'm still a feeler. Probably always will be; it's part of how God made me.

Let me throw this provocative point out there: being a strong feeler is not a weakness. It can be if we allow our emotions to rule over us, but it can also be a strength. As I was studying the topic of lament this week (the topic for this week's sermon), I ran across this quote: Suffering in silence is not a Biblical virtue. Some of us may want to argue with that statement, perhaps especially European Americans. Yet nowhere in scripture does it advocate for keeping our mouths shut and "bucking up" under any circumstances.



Instead, in scripture, you'll find these ideas repeated over and over again: When you're joyful, sing to God with shouts of praise. When you're sad or afraid, cry out to God with a loud voice. When you're in need, ask God directly for His help. We are actually commanded to give voice to our emotions; not to stuff them down or ignore them or silence them. The Bible affirms emotion and encourages us to give it expression. Which is what lament is all about - giving voice to pain, sorrow, grief, despair, disappointment.

Thanks for hanging in there with me during this Lent series. We are addressing some tough themes as we journey with Jesus toward the cross. Fear not, Easter is coming! But the darkness of Good Friday is the path toward the dawn. We must walk this road first.


