Pastor KrisAnne's Korner

One of my favorite Psalms is 130. It talks about God's grace and forgiveness, our human failings, the hope we have in the Lord and the call to wait upon Him whatever we may face.

Psalm 130

1 Out of the depths I cry to you, Lord;

2 Lord, hear my voice.

Let your ears be attentive to my cry for mercy.

3 If you, Lord, kept a record of sins,

Lord, who could stand?

4 But with you there is forgiveness,

so that we can, with reverence, serve you.

5 I wait for the Lord, my whole being waits, and in his word I put my hope.

6 I wait for the Lord

more than watchmen wait for the morning, more than watchmen wait for the morning.


7 Israel, put your hope in the Lord, for with the Lord is unfailing love

for with the Lord is unfailing love and with him is full redemption.

8 He himself will redeem Israel from all their sins.

Did you catch that beautiful hint at the incarnation?
"He himself will redeem..." Knowing what salvation
would cost, God did not ask anyone else to perform the
deed. He did it himself. He took on flesh, gave up glory,
lived among His people, was betrayed and denied,
suffered and died to redeem us. He himself.

This Sunday, we are jumping backwards in Exodus a few chapters. We will celebrate communion together, so I want to focus on The Last Supper and how Jesus explains what is about to happen to him. Why must it happen? What will his suffering and death accomplish? He refers to The Passover in Exodus (Ch. 12); in fact, that is the very meal they are eating that night - The Feast of Unleavened Bread. By this time, in Jewish tradition, the simple meal of roasted lamb and unleavened bread has become more elaborate. It includes bitter herbs, salt water, dates, walnuts, hardboiled eggs, and four cups of wine that symbolize different things. We will unpack the symbolism and meaning on Sunday.



In the meantime, meditate on Psalm 130. Reflect on what it means to you that God Himself redeemed humanity. The all-powerful Creator, the all-knowing One - ever present, holy, and sovereign over all things - He is the One who stepped down and made a way for us to be saved. Surely He could have done it another way; yet He chose this way. May that fill you with awe and gratitude this week, as we prepare to celebrate communion together.
